Taking the Gospel to Each

We know well the Great Commission that Jesus gave to His followers: “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature” (Mark 16:15). But how do we go about that? The answer is, by any legitimate means we can! Whatever system or practice we may use, likely they all will involve three crucial steps. So here is how to take the gospel to each and every one (note: each word, for ease of memory, has the word “each” in them):

Breach. The dictionary defines “breach” as: “break through.” In other words, we must break through whatever barriers exist and get into the presence (or at least get the attention) of others. We must come into contact with folks.

Reach. When being with others, it is vital that they know that we are truly concerned about them. Reach out in kind deeds and words. Reach out to them in some way. Show them that you care. The old axiom is true: “People will not care how much we know until they know how much we care.”

Teach. When the time is right and their hearts are receptive, it is time to teach others. Speak the truth in love (Eph. 4:15). Impart the gospel of God with clarity and enthusiasm. Teach them the truth of God’s will.
